


School of Nutrition Sciences and Food Technology

History of SNFT

In November, 1961 and upon the approval of the Cabinet of Ministers, the 'Iranian Food and Nutrition Institute' was founded as an independent entity, but affiliated to the Ministry of Health, with the mission of developing general guidelines for nutrition at the national level based on scientific studies. The Institute was supported by 'the Higher Institute of Nutrition Sciences & Food Stuff Chemistry' in terms of education.



In 1976, the former Parliament (before the Islamic Revolution in 1979) approved the establishment of 'The Iranian Institute of Nutrition Sciences & Food Technology', which was replaced by the previous one. Accordingly, in March 1977, Council of Higher Education approved the establishment of 'The School of Nutrition Sciences & Food Technology'. Since then, students in the field of nutrition and food technology have been admitted. The school consists of four departments. Today the school is running with 36 faculty members. Moreover, 303 students in associate, 3426 students in Bachelor's and 755 students in Master's and PhD degree have been graduated from this school so far.
